FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 10957 in Application No. 8112, dated September 7, 1922, authorized and directed applicant, Lookout Mountain Park Land and Water Company, to file with the Commission a certain schedule of rates, such rates to become effective as directed in a supplemental order of this Commission to be issued after satisfactory compliance with certain requirements of said Decision No. 10957 providing for improvement of its water service, these requirements contemplating the reduction of excessive pressures to those of its consumers on the lower portion of its system and such repairs to its reservoirs as would make safe from outside pollution the quality of the water stored in its reservoirs,

AND WHEREAS, the applicant has completed satisfactory improvements to its reservoirs and has submitted evidence to show that practically all consumers on the lower portion of the system are satisfied with the service subsequent to the installation of meters and of an electric motor to replace the gas engine formerly used, and has expressed its willingness to install pressure reducers in any instances where such installa-

tion is found necessary,

And it now appearing that applicant should be authorized to charge for all service rendered in accordance with the schedule outlined in the order of the Commission's Decision No.10957, referred to above.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the State of California that the Lookout Mountain Park Land and Water Company be and it is hereby authorized and directed to file with this Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this order the schedule of rates outlined in the order of the Commission's Decision No.10957, in Application No.8112, dated September 7, 1922, and charge in accordance with this schedule for all service rendered on and after December 1, 1922.
