
SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Peninsular Railway Company, a corporation and San Jose Railroads, a corporation, having on October 11, 1922 filed with the Commission a supplemental application for the authority to amend a certain contract dealing with the joint use of trackage in the County of Santa Clara and similar except as to date of termination and superseding that heretofore approved by the Commission in Decision No. 10487 in the application herein and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case where a public hearing is necessary and it further appearing that the application should be granted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Peninsular Railway Company, a corporation, and San Jose Railroads, a corporation, be and are hereby authorized to enter into that certain contract dated March 1, 1922 attached to the supplemental application herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 10487 be and it is hereby rescinded.
