O R D E R

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY reports in this proceeding that it is the owner of certain real property not specifically described in its mortgage or deed of trust dated November 1, 1909 and executed to the Harris Trust and Savings Bank and Los Angeles Trust and Savings Bank, Trustees, nor in its mortgage or deed of trust dated July 1, 1917 and executed to the Harris Trust and Savings Bank and Pacific-Southwest Trust and Savings Bank (formerly Los Angeles Trust and Savings Bank) as trustees, nor in any supplements to said mortgages or deeds of trust.

Applicant asks permission to execute a supplemental trust indenture subjecting the property it now owns and which is not specifically described in the aforementioned mortgages or deeds of trust to the liens of said mortgages or deeds of trust. A copy of the supplemental trust indenture is on file in this proceeding.


The Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that this application should be granted, as herein provided.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby authorized to execute a supplemental trust indenture substantially in the same form as the supple-

mental trust indenture filed in this proceeding and marked "Exhibit A";

PROVIDED, that the authority herein granted to execute a supplemental trust indenture is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted in so far as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said supplemental trust indenture as to such other legal requirements to which said supplemental trust indenture may be subject.
