SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 8726 in the above entitled proceeding, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile passenger stage line between Palo Alto and Woodside and intermediate points.

Condition No. 3 of the certificate provided that such operative right could not be discontinued without the written consent of the Railroad Commission, and it now appearing that applicant abandoned service several weeks after the certificate was granted without first securing authorization for such abandonment, and good cause appearing,
