ORDER

William Swanson and R. J. Briggs have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing Swanson to sell and Briggs to purchase an automobile stage line operated between Three Rivers and Hammond, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by W. A. Swanson under Decisions Nos. 5913 and 6125 in Application No. 4163, dated November 14th, 1918 and February 13, 1919, respectively. This operative right authorizes the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Three Rivers and Hammond.

The consideration to be paid for the property herein sought to be transferred is given as the nominal sum of \$1.00. No equipment or other tangible property is involved.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant William Swanson shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules now on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 of the Commission.
2. Applicant R. J. Briggs shall immediately file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules, or shall adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules heretofore filed by applicant Swanson. All rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Swanson.
3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.
4. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Briggs unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
