SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 11107, dated October 14, 1922, authorized SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY to sell \$5,160,000.00 of its general and refunding mortgage bonds, subject to the condition, among others, that the proceeds, other than accrued interest, be deposited with a bank or banks, or with a trust company or trust companies, and expended only for such purposes as the Commission might authorize; and

WHEREAS, applicant on December 11, 1922, filed a supplemental petition in the above entitled matter in which it reports that prior to October 31, 1922, it expended for construction purposes the sum of \$867,203.25 which has not been paid or provided for through the issue of stock or bonds; and

WHEREAS, applicant asks permission to use \$867,203.25 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the \$5,160,000 of bonds authorized by Decision No. 11107 to finance these expenditures, which are reported in detail in "Exhibit No. 8" filed in this proceeding; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes it should be granted as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use \$867,203.25 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the \$5,150,000.00 of bonds, the sale of which is authorized by Decision No. 11107, dated October 14, 1922, to finance its construction expenditures reported in its Exhibit No. 8 filed in the above entitled matter on December 11, 1922.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 11107, dated October 14, 1922, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Sixth Supplemental Order.
