O R D E R

By the Commission.

Southern Pacific Company having heretofore on June 22nd, 1912, filed with this Commission its application for permission to construct at grade a spur track as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing at the proposed point of crossing; and it further appearing that the applicant has secured the necessary franchise or permit for the crossing from the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California, and that said application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to construct its track at grade across the public highway known as Myrtle Avenue, in the town of Los Alamitos, Orange County, California, between Cerritos Street and SanSalito Street, and as shown by the map attached to said application, subject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) The entire expense necessary to construct and complete said crossing shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company.
- (2) The company shall hereafter forever maintain said crossing in good and first-class condition for the use of the public.

(3) The grades of approach shall not exceed 8 percent, and the width of the crossing shall not be less than 24 feet.

(4) The company shall ballast said crossing with gravel, broken stone, or other first-class material suitable for the purpose.

(5) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demands such action.
