O R D E R.

Great Western Power Company having applied to this Commission for a certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of the rights and privileges granted to applicant by the city of Oakland in Ordinance No. 477 W.S., adopted June 9, 1913, by which Ordinance applicant is given the right to erect, construct, operate and maintain, for a period of 35 years, an electrical distribution system in the city of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, but that considering all the circumstances surrounding the case the application may be granted ex parte,--

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED, that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by Great Western Power Company of the rights and privileges granted to said Company by the city of Oakland in Ordinance No. 477 W.S., adopted June 9, 1913.
