Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a certain spur or team track located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Highland Avenue and Santa Monica Boulevard in the County of Los Angeles, the location of said spur or team track being more fully shown on a blue print map marked "C.E.-5573" filed as an exhibit with the application herein.

The application alleges that no public need requires the continued maintenance and operation of the track proposed to be abandoned for the reason that other track facilities have been provided for the use of the patrons of applicant.

An inspection having been made and the Commission being now fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted,
