BY THE COMMISSION,

O R D E R

L. L. Ellis and E. I. Ryker have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing Ellis to sell and Ryker to purchase an automobile stage line operated between Angiola and Alpaugh, California.

The operative right herein sought to be transferred was secured by applicant Ellis under Decision No. 7681 in Application No. 5686, dated June 8, 1920 and authorizes the operation of a stage line as a common carrier of passengers and express between the points hereinabove mentioned.

Inasmuch as no consideration is involved in the transfer herein sought, the operative right being the only property to be transferred, we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions.

1. Applicant Ellis shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

2. Applicant Ryker shall immediately file, in duplicate, in his own name, tariff of rates and time schedules or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules as filed by applicant Ellis. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Ellis.

3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred shall never be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Ryker unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
