FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, Home Telephone Company of Covina in Application Number 8390, asked the Railroad Commission for permission to sell certain of its properties, described therein, to Mrs. Jane C. Stewart for the sum of \$4,750.00, which request the Commission granted by its Decision Number 11272, dated November 23, 1922, and

WHEREAS, applicant on December 18, 1922, filed a statement on the above entitled matter in which it reports that an error was made by it in the description of the properties reported in application Number 8390 and that it desires to sell the properties to Olive Stewart instead of Jane C. Stewart as authorized in Decision Number 11272, and

WHEREAS, applicant asks the Railroad Commission to modify its order so as to permit it to sell the properties as described in the statement filed on December 18th to Olive Stewart, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes it should be granted, as herein provided, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 11272, dated November 23, 1922 be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit Home Telephone Company of Covina to sell the properties described in this application as modified by the statement filed in this

proceeding on December 18, 1922 to Olive Stewart for \$4,750.00 and to use the proceeds to construct the building referred to in Decision Number 11272.
