ORDER ON PETITION FOR REHEARING

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BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Under Decision No. 11268, dated November 23, 1922, in the above entitled proceeding, this Commission held that the operations of Frank McKelverry and Stephen Salles, defendants, between Camps A, B, K and R, Fourteen Mile Stone, Placerville and Sacramento were in violation of the provisions of Chapter 213, Statutes of 1917, and amendments thereto and directed that such operations be forthwith discontinued.

On November 29, 1922, defendants through their attorney, filed a petition for rehearing which contained certain allegations with reference to the lawfulness of said Decision No. 11268 and further that the evidence was not sufficient to warrant the finding therein contained.
