ORDER APPROVING INTERLOCKING PLANT,

By the Commission,

PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, on February 3d,
1913, filed with the Commission, plans for a proposed standard inter-
locking plant to be constructed at the crossing of its railroad,
with the railroad of the Southern Pacific Company, near Raymer, Los
Angeles County, California, such plans being filed in accordance with
Section 3 of the Order of the Commission issued in Application Number
221, December 10, 1912. An Order was issued by this Commission
February 4, 1913, approving the plans for the interlocking plant.

The Pacific Electric Railway Company having constructed the
interlocking plant in accordance with the plans and specifications ap-
proved by this Commission February 4, 1913, and an Inspector of the
Commission having visited the interlocking plant and found same to
be constructed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications,
and having found it to be satisfactory and to meet the requirements for
the protection of such crossing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operation of said interlocking
plant be and the same is hereby authorized by this Commission.
