O R D E R

Central California Traction Company, a corporation,
having on January 11, 1923 filed with the Commission an applica-
tion for permission to construct a main line track at grade across
one track of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, at
the intersection of "P" Street and Eighth Street, and across the
two tracks of said Pacific Gas and Electric Company at the inter-
section of "T" Street and Eighth Street; across two tracks of
Western Pacific Railroad Company crossing Eighth Street between
"R" Street and the alley located between said "R" and "Q" Streets
and across one track of Southern Pacific Company at the intersec-
tion of "R" Street and Eighth Street, all in the City of Sacramento
County of Sacramento, as hereinafter indicated, and it
appearing that said Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Western
Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company have

consented to the construction of said crossing at grade, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the necessary franchise or permit (No. 877) has been granted by said City of Sacramento for the construction of said main line track, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossings with the said tracks, and this application should be granted subject to the conditions herein specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission be and it is hereby granted Central California Traction Company to construct one main line track at grade across one track of Pacific Gas and Electric Company at the intersection of Eighth Street and "P" Street and two tracks of Pacific Gas and Electric Company at Eighth Street and "M" Street; across two tracks of Western Pacific Railroad Company crossing Eighth Street between "R" Street and the alley between said "R" and "Q" Streets across one track of Southern Pacific at the intersection of Eighth Street and "R" Street, in the City of Sacramento and County of Sacramento, as shown by the map attached to the application; said crossings are to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz:-

(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossings, together with the cost of their maintenance thereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.

(2) All trains, motors and cars of applicant shall stop immediately before going upon or over said crossing of said tracks of Southern Pacific Company and Western Pacific Railroad Company and shall not proceed thereover until it shall have been ascertained that it is safe so to do.

(3) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter,

notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossings.

(4) The authorization herein granted for the installation of said crossings shall lapse and become void one year from the date of this order unless farther time is granted by subsequent order.

(5) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
