SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under date of October 3, 1922, the Railroad Commission issued Decision No. 11051 in the above entitled proceeding in which the San Diego Electric Railway Company was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile bus line as a common carrier of passengers between Edgeware Street in Kensington Park along Adams Avenue to Park Boulevard in the City of San Diego.

This certificate was granted with the understanding that when the Electric Railway completed construction of trackage for the operation of street cars, the bus service would be abandoned and the certificate revoked. The Commission having on January 25th, 1923, received a statement signed by General Counsel for applicant, to the effect that trackage construction work had been completed and the operation of street cars commenced, and that the certificate could be revoked.
