SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 5969, dated December 3,
1918, applicant herein was granted a certificate of public con-
venience and necessity authorizing the operation of an auto-
mobile truck line as a common carrier of freight and express
between Groveland, Chinese Station and intermediate points.

It now appears from a written statement received
from applicant that he has discontinued service on July 1st,
1922, without first securing authorization from the Commission
permitting such discontinuance, further that he does not in-
tend to resume service due to the fact that he has lost the
mail contract over the route which he heretofore operated, and
good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 5969 in
the above entitled proceeding be, and the same hereby is revoked
and annulled.
