SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having, by Decision No. 3724 dated September 30, 1916 (11 CRC 409) and Decision No. 5934, dated November 19, 1918 (16 CRC 226) ordered Pacific Gas and Electric Company to file semi-annual reports showing the progress made in the elimination of violations of state laws existing in its electrical transmission and distribution systems, and good cause now appearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and the same is hereby relieved of the requirements of the above mentioned orders in so far as the filing of semi-annual progress reports is concerned.
