## ORDER

By the Commission.

having on February 9, 1914 filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct a side track at grade across a public highway in the Town of Clothe. County of Fresne. State of California, as hereinafter indicated; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the Town of Clothe is not an incorporated town and therefore a franchise or permit is not necessary; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossing with said public highway and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions herein-after, specified.

IT IS REFERN ORDERED That permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to construct a side track at grade across a public highway in the Town of Clotho. Fresho County, California, as per map attached to the application and subject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing, together with the cost of its maintenance thereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public, shall be borne by applicant.
- (2) Said crossing shall be constructed of a length not less than twenty-four (24) feet with grades of

approach not exceeding six (6) per cent and shall be ballasted with first-class stone or gravel ballast to a depth of not less than cix (6) inches, and in every way made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
