O P I N I O N

At the hearing of the above entitled application, it developed that the crossing desired would accommodate a small amount of business and could only be maintained with considerable hazard to the traveling public. Amicable arrangements have been made between the County and the roads involved whereby the siding located at the point to be reached by this crossing can be reached over the right of way of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, and the representatives of the County have signified their willingness to have the application dismissed.

I submit the following order:

O R D E R .

Application having been made by the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County for a grade crossing, as specified above in the title hereto, and a hearing having been held; and

IT APPEARING that a crossing at the place desired would increase the hazard to the traveling public, and arrangements having been made whereby the shippers and receivers of freight who would be inconvenienced by this crossing are afforded access to the side

track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company over the right of way
of said Company.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above application be and
the same is hereby denied.

The foregoing opinion and order are hereby approved and
ordered filed as the opinion and order of the Railroad Commission
of the State of California.
