rates for storage heretofore filed
with the Railroad Commission of the

ORDER

North Point Dock Warehouses having filed with this Commission its application dated July 2, 1912, for permission to charge and collect in certain specified cases, rates for storage lower than the rates as set forth in schedule heretofore filed with this Commission, and this Commission having as yet been unable to make the investigations which it may hereafter make on the question of deviations of public utilities from schedules of rates filed with this Commission and this Commission being willing in the meantime to permit applicant to make the deviations specified in its application;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be and the same is hereby granted to the North Point Dock Warehouses until the further order of this Commission to charge and collect rates for storage of peanuts in sacks, canned goods in cases, sardines in cases and cement as specified in its application dated July 2, 1912, less than the charges shown in its schedule on file with this Commission.
