## ORDER

By the Commission,

SAN DIEGO AND SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY. a corporation, having on May 11, 1914, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct its track connecting a track on Thirteenth Street with a track on "L" Street, across "L" Street and Thirteenth Street, in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that the applicant has secured the necessary franchise or permit from the Common Council of the City of San Diego; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossings with said "L" Street and Thirteenth Street, and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company to construct its track, connecting a track on Thirteenth Street with a track on "L" Street, across "L" Street and Thirteenth Street, in the City of San Diego. San Diego County, California, on the west side of its main line, as shown by the map attached to the application and subject to the following conditions, viz.: - 2 -

(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossings together with the cost of their maintenance thereafter in good and firstclass condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.

(2) Said crossings shall be constructed suitable for the conditions of road traffic and in every way made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
