

In the matter of the Application
of Southern Pacific Company, a
corporation, for an order author-
izing the construction of a spur
track across Chestnut Street, City
of San Buena Ventura, Ventura
County, California.

ORDER

By the Commission:

Southern Pacific Company having heretofore on July 17, 1912, filed with this Commission its application for permission to construct at grade a spur track as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing at the proposed point of crossing and that said application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted Southern Pacific Company to construct its spur track at grade in the city of San Buena Ventura, Ventura County, California, across Chestnut street at its intersection with Front Street, on the north side of its main line in Front Street, to the property of the Channel Commercial Company, as shown by the map attached to the application subject to the following conditions:

(1) Southern Pacific Company shall construct said crossing and forever hereafter maintain same in good and first-class condition for the use of the public.

(2) Said crossing shall be of a length not less than the length of the present crossing of said company on Chestnut street, and shall be ballasted in a good and substantial manner with gravel or broken stone.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance, and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission, if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
