

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of ORO ELECTRIC CORPORATION for a Certificate under Section 50(a) of the Public Utilities Act that the present and future public convenience and necessity require and will require the construction of transmission and distribution lines for electric service in the counties of Plumas, Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Glenn, Yolo, Solano, Contra Costa, Alameda, Sacramento, San Joaquin and Calaveras and an extension in and through said counties of the existing lines of said corporation; and for a preliminary order under Section 50(c) of said Act declaring that the Commission will hereafter upon application therefor, after said corporation has obtained franchises and permits it contemplates securing, but which have not yet been granted to it, issue the necessary certificate or certificates that the present or future public convenience and necessity require or will require the exercise of the rights and privileges granted by said contemplated franchises and permits to construct, maintain and operate transmission and distribution lines and equipment in said counties.
