pearing that the proceeds derived from these notes were used for purpos-
es which are properly capitalizable and that applicant desires to re-
new these notes from time to time until plans for reorganization, which
are now under way, have been entirely completed, and the Commission
being of the opinion that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company
of California be and it hereby is authorized to renew from time to
time the above mentioned notes or any of them, upon the following con-
ditions and not otherwise, to wit:

1. In no case shall the rate of interest of any of said notes
be increased upon renewal.
2. Any of said notes may be renewed from time to time up to and
including June 30, 1915, but in no case shall the term of renewal of

any of said notes extend beyond June 30, 1916.

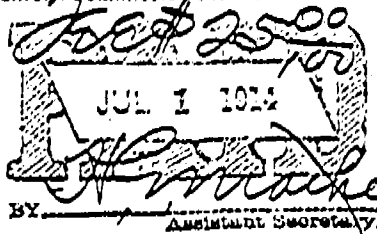
3. Applicant shall keep separate, true and accurate accounts of the renewed notes herein authorized to be issued, and shall on or before the 24th day of the month make a verified report to this Commission setting forth the notes which have been renewed during the preceding month, together with the term, amount and rate of interest of the renewed notes, all in accordance with this Commission's Order No. 24, which, in so far as applicable, is made a part of this Order.

The payment of the fee prescribed in Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act shall be a condition precedent to the effectiveness of this Order.

The foregoing Order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
