AMENDMENT TO ORDER.

The Order of the Commission made in the above en-  
titled proceedings on May 9, 1913, having provided in part that  
Lawndale Land & Water Company be given authority to make a mort-  
gage of its property to Los Angeles Abstract & Trust Company, da-  
ted July 1, 1912, to secure a bonded indebtedness of the face value  
of \$50,000.00 and to issue under said mortgage bonds of the face  
value of \$25,000.00.

AND IT APPEARING that said Los Angeles Abstract &  
Trust Company has gone out of existence, and the Commission having  
been asked to substitute in the place of said company the Los An-  
geles Trust & Savings Bank and also to change the date of the mort-  
gage from July 1, 1912, to July 1, 1914,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order heretofore made in  
this proceeding on May 9, 1913, be and the same hereby is amended  
so as to substitute the name of Los Angeles Trust & Savings Bank in  
the place of Los Angeles Abstract & Trust Company and to substitute  
July 1, 1914, in the place of July 1, 1912, as the date of the mort-  
gage to secure the bonds therein authorized to be issued; the original  
Order in all other respects to remain unaltered.

The foregoing Amendment to Order is hereby approved  
and ordered filed as the Amendment to Order of the Railroad Commission  
of the State of California.
