

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ORO ELECTRIC CORPORATION be, in renewal of the notes, and it is hereby authorized to issue its promissory notes above mentioned, upon the following conditions, and not otherwise, to-wit:

1. The face value of the notes issued shall not exceed the face value of the notes renewed.
2. The rate of interest of the notes issued shall not exceed seven per cent per annum, nor the term of any note extend beyond September 15, 1915.
3. Applicant shall make a verified report to this Commission of all notes issued in accordance with this order, specifying the notes which have been renewed thereby.
4. The authority herein granted to issue notes shall apply only to notes issued on or before December 31, 1914.

The foregoing opinion and order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the opinion and order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
