O R D E R

This Commission having, in its order made on May 18, 1914, in Application No. 936, being the application of the City of Glendale that the Railroad Commission fix the valuation of certain water systems to be transferred to said City, found as a fact that \$14,241.00 represents the fair compensation to be paid by the City of Glendale for certain property of the Verdugo Pipe & Reservoir Company specified in detail in said order, and the Verdugo Pipe & Reservoir Company having filed the present application asking for the authority of this Commission to sell said property to the City of Glendale, and the Commission being of the opinion that this matter does not require a hearing and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Verdugo Pipe & Reservoir Company be, and it hereby is authorized to transfer to the City of Glendale all the real property, pumping plants and distribution system described in detail in Finding No. 4 in the order of this Commission made on May 18, 1914, in Application No. 936.
