ORDER.

This Commission, in its order made on May 18, 1914, in Application No. 936, being the application of the City of Glendale that the Railroad Commission fix the value of certain water systems to be transferred to said City, found as a fact that \$69,782.66 represents the fair compensation to be paid by the City of Glendale for certain property of Title Guarantee and Trust Company specified in detail in said order, and Title Guarantee and Trust Company having filed the present application asking for the authority of this Commission to sell ^{its} certain water ^{system} to the City of Glendale, and the Commission being of the opinion that this matter does not require a hearing and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that TITLE GUARANTEE AND TRUST COMPANY be, and it is hereby authorized to transfer to the City of Glendale all of the real property, storage system, distribution system and other property described in detail in Finding No. 1 in the order of this Commission made on May 18, 1914, in Application No. 936.
