ORDER.

SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA having applied to this Commission for a certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of the rights and privileges granted to applicant by the Board of Trustees of the City of Santa Ana, Orange County, California, in Ordinance No. 553 adopted and approved on February 3, 1913, by which ordinance applicant is given the right, upon certain conditions, to construct and operate a gas distributing system in the city of Santa Ana, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.--

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted to it in Ordinance No. 553 by the Board of Trustees of the City of Santa Ana.
