ORDER.

D. A. Gatto having applied to this Commission for approval of the award to applicant of a renewal of a wharf franchise by the Board of Trustees of the City of Pittsburg, Contra Costa County, California, in Ordinance No. 22 "A" passed and adopted on November 4, 1913, by which ordinance applicant is granted a renewal for the period of twenty (20) years of that certain wharf franchise granted by the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County on March 16, 1896, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the sale and award to D. A. Gatto by the Board of Trustees of the City of Pittsburg in ordinance No. 22 "A" of the renewal for twenty (20) years of the wharf franchise theretofore granted applicant by the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County on March 16, 1896, be, and the same is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall not become effective until applicant shall have filed with the City Clerk of the City of Pittsburg a certified copy of this order.
