Decision No. 187

In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, for permission to construct certain tracks at grade across 9th street and Dayton Avenue, Chico, Butte county, California.

Application No. 186.

ORDER

By the Commission.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, having on August 15, 1912, filed with the Commission its application for permission to construct at grade its sidetrack across 9th street and Dayton Avenue, city of Chico, Butte county, California, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossings at the proposed points of crossing; and it further appearing that said application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to construct its sidetrack at grade across 9th street and Dayton Avenue, city of Chico, Butte county, California, said track beginning on the east line of 9th street about sixteen (16) feet south of the center of the main line of said company; thence extending easterly across Little Chico Creek and across Dayton Avenue to a connection with the present sidetrack of said company, as shown by the map attached to the application and subject to the following conditions, viz.:

(1) The entire expense of constructing the crossings and the expense of their maintenance hereafter in good and first-class condition shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company.

(2) The crossings shall be provided with the necessary plank or guard rails and constructed of sufficient width to properly care for the traffic and shall be ballasted with first-class broken stone or gravel ballast and in every way made safe for the passage of vehicles and other road traffic.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
