O R D E R

By the Commission,

STOCKTON ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corpor-  
ation, having on September 24, 1914, filed with the Commission  
an application for permission to construct its tracks at grade  
across Lower Sacramento Road, near the City of Stockton, San Joaquin  
County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to  
the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is  
necessary; that Lower Sacramento Road is not within the incorporated  
limits of the City of Stockton, but that applicant has secured a  
franchise, of date March 3, 1914, from the Board of Supervisors of  
San Joaquin County, granting permission for the construction of  
said crossing at grade; and it further appearing that it is not  
reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said Lower  
Sacramento Road, and that the application should be granted subject  
to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be hereby granted  
Stockton Electric Railway Company to construct its tracks at grade  
across Lower Sacramento Road, as shown by the map and profile attached  
to the application, and subject to the following conditions, viz.:-

(1) Said crossing to be constructed subject to the conditions of  
the franchise or permit hereinbefore mentioned, and shall in every way  
be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road  
traffic.

(2) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
