

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for authority to renew a promissory note in the sum of \$100,000.

ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having made application to this Commission for authority to issue a promissory note in the sum of \$100,000 for a period of ninety days, with interest at 6 per cent per annum, to The National Conduit and Cable Company to renew a note of like amount, with similar interest rate, to The National Conduit and Cable Company;

And a hearing having been held and it appearing that the purposes for which the applicant herein proposes to issue said note are not in whole or in part chargeable to operating expenses or to income;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be given authority and it is hereby given authority to issue a promissory note or renewals thereof in the sum of \$100,000 to The National Conduit and Cable Company, said note or notes to bear interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum and to be due and payable not later than October 20, 1915.

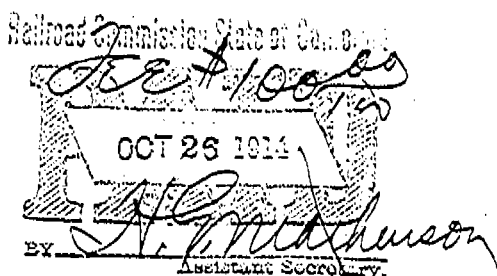
The authority herein granted is granted upon the following conditions and not otherwise:

(1) The applicant shall report within thirty days after the note herein authorized to be issued has been issued, stating in writing to this Commission that such note has been issued and the note to renew which it has been issued has been canceled.

(2) The authority herein granted is conditioned upon the payment by the applicant of the fee prescribed under the Public Utilities Act.

The foregoing Order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
