ORDER

By the Commission.

SAN DIEGO AND SOUTH EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY, a corpora-
tion, having on November 2, 1914 filed with the Commission its ap-
plication for permission to discontinue and take up a spur track
at a point near Grossmont, in San Diego County, California, this
spur track being about thirteen hundred and thirty-five (1335)
feet long, and running from the applicant's main line to a point
near a quarry owned by Ed. Fletcher, in San Diego County; and it
appearing to the Commission that the removal of said spur track is
made necessary by the construction of a State highway in this
neighborhood; and that there is no objection on the part of the
users to the removal of this spur; and it further appearing that
this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be hereby granted
San Diego and South Eastern Railway Company to discontinue and take
up said spur track near Grossmont, in San Diego County.
