ORDER

Western States Gas and Electric Company having made application to this Commission for authority to issue \$45,000 in promissory notes to H. M. Byllesby & Company for the purpose of refunding promissory notes of like amount,

And a hearing having been held and it appearing that the purposes for which the applicant proposes to issue said promissory notes are proper purposes as defined by the Public Utilities Act,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western States Gas and Electric Company be granted authority and it is hereby granted authority to issue promissory notes in the sum of \$45,000.

The authority herein granted is granted upon the following conditions and not otherwise:

(1) The notes herein authorized to be issued shall bear date of December, 1914 and shall be in form and amount as follows:

\$5,000 payable December 11, 1915, rate of interest
6 per cent per annum,

\$10,000 payable December 11, 1915, rate of interest
6 per cent per annum,

\$15,000 payable December 11, 1915, rate of interest
6 per cent per annum,

\$15,000 payable December 13, 1915, rate of interest
6 per cent per annum.

(2) The notes herein authorized to be issued shall be used for the sole purpose of refunding notes in the sum of \$45,000, payable to H. M. Byllesby & Company, maturing in December, 1914.

(3) The authority herein granted shall apply to such notes as shall have been issued on or before March 1, 1915.

(4) The applicant herein shall report to this Commission within thirty days after the notes herein authorized to be issued have been issued, stating that such notes have been issued and stating the note or notes canceled or refunded.

(5) The authority herein granted is conditioned upon the payment of the fee prescribed under the Public Utilities Act.
