SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 20th this Commission issued an order reopening this case and held a hearing therein at Los Angeles on Monday, July 27th. No new evidence was presented at that time, but the Commission's attention was directed to an apparent error in its former order in this matter issued on June 29, 1914. It was intended by the order to afford shippers the opportunity to initially ice shipments of eggs from Petaluma to Los Angeles if they so desired, and not to place upon them exclusively the duty of so doing in cases where icing was desired; therefore, the order should be amended to properly express the intention, and changed to read: "shippers may provide for the initial icing of eggs from Petaluma to Los Angeles", and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of this Commission heretofore made in this proceeding on June 29, 1914, be and the same is hereby amended to provide that "shippers may provide for the initial icing of eggs from Petaluma to Los Angeles."
