SUPPLEMENTARY OPINION.

By opinion and order dated June 27th, 1914, this complaint was dismissed as to the Ocean Park Heights Land and Water Company, a corporation, and continued for future hearing as to Anna Dell Segno. Since that time it has come to the knowledge of the Commission that the defendant has improved the water system serving the complainant and some seventy others in practical compliance with suggestions made during the formal hearing in this matter, preceding the original order, and set forth in the opinion and order above cited.

The actual construction work completed and the cost thereof, as well as the resulting effect upon the water system and the supply provided consumers, are matters of record before the Commission in its action on Application #1374 filed by Anna Dell Segno asking an investigation of the value of applicant's property and establishment of just and reasonable rates to be charged consumers in Ocean Park Heights District.

It appears that now the quality and quantity of service should be satisfactory, and I believe that no further hearing is necessary.

I submit herewith the following form of supplementary order:

O R D E R.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the State of California that the above entitled complaint be and the same is hereby dismissed.
