BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

It appearing that in renewing the note of the face value of \$19,000 which, by orders heretofore made in these proceedings, Los Angeles and San Diego Beach Railway Company is authorized to issue to Citizens National Bank of Los Angeles, applicant desires to issue two notes of the face value of \$15,000 and \$4,000, respectively, instead of issuing one note of the face value of \$19,000, and the Commission being of the opinion that this request is reasonable and that it should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in renewing applicant's note of the face value of \$19,000, payable to Citizens National Bank of Los Angeles, in accordance with the authority heretofore granted by this Commission, applicant may, in lieu of issuing one note of the face value of \$19,000, issue two notes of the face value of \$15,000 and \$4,000, respectively, provid-

ing, that in all other respects the renewal notes shall be issued in accordance with the orders heretofore made in these proceedings.
