ORDER

T. G. Schmeiser, et al., freeholders of Yolo county, California, having on August 22, 1912, filed with this Commission an application for authority to vacate and abandon portions of certain public highways now crossing the property of Southern Pacific Railroad Company in the town of Davisville, Yolo county, California, as herein-after indicated, and a public hearing having been held at Woodland on September 4, 1912, at which applicants and other parties interested were represented; and it appearing from the testimony taken at said hearing that it is reasonable and practicable and in the interest of the public that said application be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted to applicants, to the Board of Supervisors of said Yolo county, and to Southern Pacific Railroad Company to vacate, abandon and close to public use the following public highways in the said town of Davisville, viz.:

- (1) All that portion of First street lying between a line drawn parallel to and one hundred and ten (110) feet north of the north line of Olive street and the south line of Plum street.

(2) All that portion of Pine street lying between a line drawn parallel to and two hundred and eighty (280) feet west of the west line of Front street and a line drawn parallel to and two hundred and eighty (280) feet east of the east line of Second street.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall be hereafter subject to such amendment, revision or modification as to this Commission may seem just and proper and this Commission reserves the right to revoke the permission hereby given if public convenience and necessity demand such action.

The foregoing order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
