BY THE COMMISSION:

The Collins Commercial Company having applied to this Commission for a certificate declaring that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of rights and privileges granted to the said company by the City of Newport Beach in a permit dated September 4, 1912, which permit gives to the said company the right to suspend, in accordance with certain conditions therein prescribed, two electric wires across the intersection of Palm Street and Bay Avenue, in said City of Newport Beach, and, this Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED That public convenience and necessity require the exercise by the Collins Commercial Company of the rights and privileges granted to said company by the City of Newport Beach, in a permit dated September 4, 1912.
