ORDER OF DISMISSAL.

The applicants in the above entitled proceeding having filed their petition herein asking that the Railroad Commission make its order suspending Supplement No. 46 to Southern Pacific Company's Local Joint and Proportional Freight Tariff C.R.C.No.699, containing certain reductions in the rates on lumber and its products from Cole, Weed, Redding, Anderson, Cottonwood, Red Bluff, Chico, Marysville, Yuba City, Honcut and points on the Klamath Falls Branch of said company to Sacramento and points in the San Joaquin Valley, to become effective May 25, 1915, and a public hearing having been held on said application and the Southern Pacific Company having thereafter filed its Supplement No. 49, effective May 25, 1915, making certain reductions in the rates on lumber and its products from San Joaquin Valley mills to Sacramento, and having thereafter filed its Supplement No. 50 to said Local Joint and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 634, C. R. C. 699, making reductions on lumber and its products from said San Joaquin Valley mills to designated points, being Roseville, Auburn, Clipper Gap, Applegate, New England Mills, Colfax and Cape Horn, Acacia of Sacramento, and the Commission being of the opinion, in view of all the facts, that the effective date of said Supplement No. 46 to Southern Pacific Company's Local Joint and Proportional

Freight Tariff C. R. C. No. 699 should not be suspended, and
having permitted the same to become effective on said May 25, 1915.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding
be and the same is hereby dismissed.
