ORDER

THE MCCARTHY COMPANY having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles for the sum of \$2,500.00 a certain public utility water system owned by said The McCarthy Company, which system supplies approximately 2,000 persons in the territory lying easterly of Moneta Avenue and northerly of Florence Avenue, and in the territory lying southerly of Florence Avenue and westerly of Hoover Street; and the City of Los Angeles, through its Board of Public Service Commissioners, having joined in this application, and the terms of the transfer being as set forth in a form of deed attached to the application in this proceeding, marked "Exhibit B," which deed describes the property to be transferred as follows:

(a) All water pipes, service connections, meters, material and supplies on hand, consisting of water meters approximately ten in number, pipe, fittings and tools, pertaining to the system known as the Water Works of the Greater Los Angeles Water Company, and owned by said first party and supplying water in the territory lying easterly of Moneta Avenue and northerly of Florence Avenue in the City of Los Angeles, and in the territory lying southerly of Florence Avenue and westerly of Hoover Street in said City; including mains, connections and appurtenances in said

Florence Avenue and in Sixty-sixth Street west of Main Street, and all extensions of said water system in or outside of said City.

(b) All franchises and rights of way owned or held by or for said party of the first part and used or necessary in connection with the construction or operation of said works, or any part thereof, or any extension of said works.

(c) All maps and records pertaining to said water system and relating to pipes, services, consumers property ratings, etc.

and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that said application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said application be, and the same is hereby, granted.
