ORDER

EDWARD STOLL having applied to this Commission for authority to transfer to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles for the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a certain public utility water system owned by said Stoll, which system supplies approximately 1,000 persons in the City of Los Angeles in territory lying southerly of Slauson Avenue, westerly of Estrella Avenue, northerly of 65th Street and easterly of Budlong Avenue; and the City of Los Angeles, through its Board of Public Service Commissioners, having joined in this application, and the terms of the transfer being as set forth in a form of deed attached to the application in this proceeding, marked "Exhibit A", which deed describes the property to be transferred as follows:

- (a) All water pipes, service connections and extensions constituting and pertaining to the water distributing system known as the "Edward Stoll Water Supply" in said City of Los Angeles, owned, used and operated by said Edward Stoll for supplying water in
