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BY THE COMMISSION:

WHEREAS, a number of the residents of Beaumont, California, have made complaint to this Commission with reference to the rates and service of the San Gorgonio Water Company and the Beaumont Land and Water Company; and

WHEREAS, this Commission finds that public necessity requires that it make an investigation into the rates and service of said companies;

NOW, WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this Commission institute, on its own initiative, under the provisions of Section 60 of the Public Utilities Act, an inquiry into the matter entitled as above, and that the Secretary of this Commission be and he is hereby instructed to notify said San Gorgonio Water Company and said Beaumont Land and Water Company to appear before this Commission on Friday, November 1, 1912, at 2 P.M. at Beaumont, California, at which time and place said San Gorgonio Water Company and said Beaumont Land and Water Company may appear and be heard in said matter; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that if either the San Gorgonio Water Company, or the Beaumont Land and Water Company do not appear at said time and place, such company shall be guilty of contempt of this Commission, and subject to the penalties prescribed by said Public Utilities Act; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that Case No. 275, entitled John Johnson vs. San Gorgonio Water Company and Beaumont Land and Water Company, and Case No. 280, entitled May H. Gray vs.

San Geronimo Water Company and Beaumont Land and Water Company, which cases have heretofore been filed with this Commission, be and the same hereby are merged into this investigation herein ordered by the Commission upon its own initiative, and the Secretary of this Commission is hereby instructed to notify the said John Johnson and the said May K. Gray that each of them may appear at the time and place hereinbefore specified and be heard upon the matters set forth in the complaints filed in said cases Nos. 275 and 280.
