ORDER

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, Merced County, California, having on May 11, 1915, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct a public highway at grade over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Amsterdam, Merced County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that applicant has secured an easement from Southern Pacific Company for the construction of said crossing at grade, and it further appearing to the Commission that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said track, and that the application should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be hereby granted Board of Supervisors, Merced County, California, to construct a public highway at grade over the track of Southern Pacific Company, in Section 5, Township 6 South, Range 13 East, M. D. B. & M., Merced County, California, said crossing being located near Amsterdam station, as shown by the map and profile attached to the application, and to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz.:-
