THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad Company requests this Commission to amend Decision No. 514, dated March 20, 1913, so as to permit it to sell at 80 per cent. of face value and accrued interest, enough bonds to realize \$1,515.85, the estimated cost of a shop building and engine house.

Eastern Railroad Company be given authority, and it is hereby given authority, to sell \$2,000.00 face value of its first mortgage six per cent. gold bonds, and to use the proceeds obtained from the sale of said bonds to construct a shop building and engine house, the cost of which is estimated at \$1.515.85, as per statement attached to this application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 514 of this Commission authorizing applicant to sell bonds be amended so as to extend the time to October 31, 1915, in which the applicant may issue \$2,000.00 and no more of the bonds therein authorized.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the bonds herein suthorized to be issued shall be issued and sold on or before October 31, 1915 and shall net the applicant not less than 80 per cent. of face value plus accrued interest thereon.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the orders made by this Commission in the above entitled proceeding shall remain in full force and effect except as to those provisions and conditions which may be in conflict with this Third Supplemental Order.

The foregoing Third Supplemental Order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Third Supplemental Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
