SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission being advised that since the original order in this proceeding was made all of the users of water from the system of the San Joaquin & Kings River Canal & Irrigation Company, in Stanislaus County, during the past season have agreed to the rate of \$2.25 per acre per season, and it appearing to the Commission, therefore, that it is proper to allow applicant to put into effect for water supplied in Stanislaus County, a rate of \$2.25 per acre per season,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be, and the same is hereby, granted, this order to supersede the order heretofore made on December 22, 1914.
