BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, this Commission in an order dated July 24, 1915 (Decision No. 2633), authorized MT. WHITNEY POWER AND ELECTRIC COMPANY to pledge \$440,000 face value of bonds as collateral security for notes given Tulare County Power Company; and

WHEREAS applicant now asks this Commission to amend its order so as to permit it to pledge said \$440,000 face value of bonds to secure the notes, the proceeds of which are to be used to pay the notes given to Tulare County Power Company,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission's order dated July 24, 1915 (Decision No. 2633), be amended, and hereby is amended so as to permit Mt. Whitney Power and Electric Company to pledge the bonds therein authorized to secure notes, the proceeds of which are to be used to pay the notes given to Tulare County Power Company.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Commission's order dated July 24, 1915 (Decision No. 2633) remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this first supplemental

order.
