FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, this Commission in an order dated July 25, 1915 (Decision No. 2629), authorized MT. WHITNEY POWER AND ELECTRIC COMPANY[†] to acquire the property of the TULARE COUNTY POWER COMPANY and to issue^{to} said Tulare County Power Company in payment for said property its promissory notes; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Whitney Power and Electric Company has asked this Commission to amend its order so as to permit it to issue its notes for the same amount and the same maturity to parties other than said Tulare County Power Company and to use the proceeds to be obtained through the issuance of the notes to pay the notes in favor of said Tulare County Power Company,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this Commission's order dated July 25, 1915 (Decision No. 2629) in the above entitled matter be, and hereby is amended, so as to permit Mt. Whitney Power and Electric Company to issue its notes

authorized in said order to parties other than Tulare County Power Company.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the proceeds to be obtained through the issuance of the notes herein authorized to be issued shall be used to pay and retire the notes in favor of Tulare County Power Company.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Commission's order dated July 23, 1915 (Decision No. 2629) shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
