## Third Supplemental Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Section five of this Commission's order, dated June 30, 1915, (Decision No. 2550) be amended so as to read:

"The proceeds obtained from the sale of \$74,000 face value of bonds herein authorized shall be deposited by Western States Gas and Electric Company in a special account to be expended as the work for the extensions, additions and betterments progresses. The proceeds obtained from the sale of \$10,000 face value of bonds herein authorized shall be delivered to the company to reimburse it for the extensions, additions and betterments made by it during the month of May, 1915, in accordance with its report accompanying said supplemental application; the remaining \$182,000 face value of said bonds may be delivered to the Company from time to time as reports showing the making of extensions, additions and betterments to its property are filed with, and approved by, this Commission."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Third Supplemental Order shall supersede and be in lieu of the Second Supplemental Order heretofore issued in this matter on August 18, 1915, (Decision No. 2697). IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Second Supplemental Order in this matter, dated August 18, 1915 (Decision No. 2697) be and the same is hereby ordered canceled and annulled.
